

The Town Board of the Town of Trenton held a Regular Meeting at Trenton Municipal Center 8520 Old Poland Road, Barneveld, New York. Supervisor Joseph Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Present were: Councilmen Betsy Mack, Bruce Kellogg and Dan Shanley. Godfrey was absent. Also present were Thomas Hughes, Attorney, Art Hughes, Highway Superintendent, Phil Sacco, Oneida County Legislator, Larry Bogan, Joe DeTraglia, Joe Samson and Sue Martin, NOCCOG.

Privilege of the Floor

South Trenton:

- Bogan advised the Association just had a meeting.
- DeTraglia thanked the Town of Trenton for the plowing.
- DeTraglia also wants to look at reducing the speed to 45 mph on Trenton Road from Combs Road to Powell Road.
- Smith advised a petition has to be done first.

Phil Sacco-Oneida County Legislator:

- Sacco advised their board met today and they had 40 resolutions, but none that really affect us.
- Sacco advised a lot of time was spent on Fireworks sales (local law being considered to approve sales per new State Law).

Cutler joined the meeting at 7:08pm.

- Highway Superintendent Hughes asked about funding for North Gage Road repairs.
- Sacco advised he will find out and report back.

Officers Reports

Highway Superintendent – Abstract:

- Hughes discussed agreement to spend highway funds.
- Smith will table until next meeting to give time for review.
- Hughes asked about the purchase of another truck.
- Smith advised there is \$50,000 in the budget and \$25,000 from the auction.
- Mack is working on a grant.
- Smith advised we will sell another truck, should net another \$25,000.
- Mack advised she was scheduling required physicals for the Highway employees.
- Smith asked for a resolution to allow Hughes to place an order for the cab and chassis for the new truck.
- Kellogg made a motion to allow Hughes to place the order for a cab and chassis, seconded by Shanley. Roll Call: Smith, aye; Mack, aye; Kellogg, aye and Shanley, aye. Motion carried.
- Smith advised everyone has a copy of the Highway Abstract (see Exhibit A) and asked if there were any questions.
- Shanley made a motion to accept the audited Highway Vouchers Nos. 79 through 98 in the aggregate amount of \$13,879.72, seconded by Mack. Roll Call: Smith, aye; Mack, aye; Kellogg, aye and Shanley, aye. Motion carried.
