Privilege of the Floor:

-Tyler Carroll introduced himself and spoke regarding the median closures on Route 12.

-Smith advised the Dept. of Health performed an inspection at the Beach and found a couple of minor things that were corrected within the hour; we passed.

Credit Cards for Town:
