-Smith advised it would be a car rail barn where they could service some cars; they would break off the main line.

-Godfrey stated so they will actually put up a building?

-Smith, yes; they will probably want a 100 ft. by 200 ft. lot.

-Godfrey asked what it was for?

-Smith stated they would be refurbishing some of the cars; they used to use the base.

-Godfrey stated they are actually putting up a building?

-Smith advised yes, like a butler building.

-Smith stated he advised Art it was up to him, if he could spare the land.

-Godfrey asked if it was up behind the ice house (old Town Garage)?

-Smith stated yes.

-Godfrey asked if we get a choice as to what type of building they put up and what it will look like?

-Smith advised we will have a lot to say.

-Shanley stated they would have to go through Planning.

-Shanley asked about the Teamsters Contract and if it was signed?

-Smith advised not yet signed; the Union is revising, the ball is in their court.
